

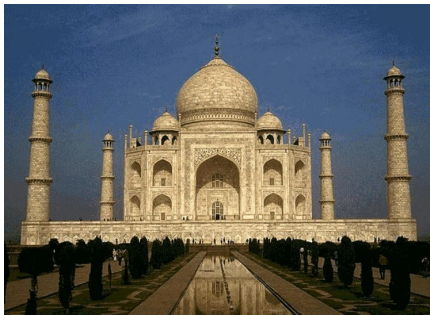

** Tour is operational on all days except Fridays, when the Taj Mahal is closed.*

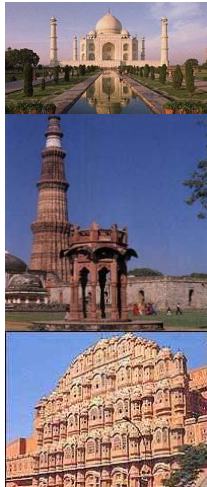
THE PINK CITY – JAIPUR ✝️

Jaipur-the Capital of Rajasthan, was once a stronghold of the Rajput rulers, where three hill forts and a number of places are important tourist attractions. it is famous for embroidered leather shoes, pottery, tie and dye products and other exotic ware. Visit the magnificent Amber Fort, City palace Museum and the Observatory. Enjoy the Maharaja Experience by riding on an elephant at the Amber Fort.





GOLDEN TRIANGLE †

(Delhi-Agra- Jaipur- Delhi 2 nights / 3 days)

Depart to Agra and, enroute, visit Sikandara Fort. In Agra, visit Jewel of the City, the Taj Mahal, which is also known as the "Monument of Love" built by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his beloved wife, Mumtaz. From Agra, drive to the exotic city of Jaipur via Fatehpur Sikri, the abandoned capital of Mughal Emperor, Akbar. Jaipur represents the Palette of the orient with its colourful people and its vibrant Rajasthani traditions. Enjoy elephant ride at Amber Fort, and visit the City Palace Museum, the Observatory, Hawa Mahal.

Then visit Saranath - the Buddha's Stupa here is a reminder of the first sermon he preached in this city.

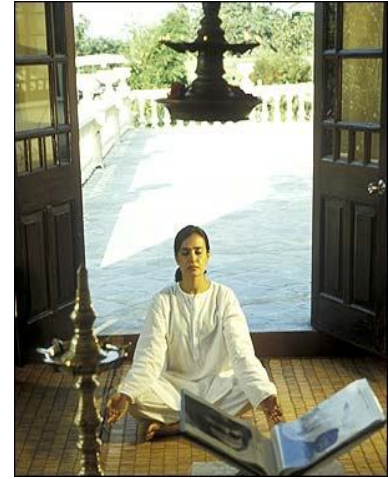

Delhi and its environs provide ample opportunity for accompanying persons to explore and enjoy the dance, music, shopping and traditional Indian hospitality.

✚ **HISTORICAL MONUMENTS – Duration 5 – 6 hrs.**
Tour Cost : Rs 1,300 per person

Visit the Humayun's Tomb, aptly called the precursor of the Taj Mahal. Drive past Safdarjung's Tomb, and visit the Qutab Minar, 72 meters high and one of the perfect towers of the Persian world. Nearby amidst the ruins of the Quwut-ul-Islam stands the Iron Pillar which has stood the vagaries of weather and not rusted over 1500 years. Drive past – India Gate.



✚ **OLD DELHI – Duration 5 - 6 hrs.**
Tour Cost : Rs 1,300 per person



Delhi is an ancient city, formerly the site of eight different cities. All these cities were built in different periods of history, but at the same place. Various monuments from these different periods of history still exists and are in good form. The old city of Delhi houses the largest mosque in India - Jama Masjid. If you seek serenity and peace of mind, this is the place for you. The hustle of everyday life can be savoured in Chandni Chowk's narrow by-lanes. Its small shops, reminders of an era when this was Delhi's main market place, offer a wide variety of typically Indian wares such as bangles, attar (Indian perfume), incense etc. Also visit Shah Jehan's Red Fort, whose ramparts bore witness to the coming of the British and now proudly proclaim the independence of India, every August 15.

✚ **DELHI BY NIGHT – Duration 5 - 6 hrs.**
Tour Cost : Rs 2,500 per person

India is endowed with a rich heritage of art and culture. Classical Indian dance and music owe their origins to temple and religious festivals. Delhi is a perennial venue for performances and recitals and an hour of experience is worth years of memory. The music and dance performance is followed by a sumptuous dinner at a first class restaurant. A perfect evening after a perfect day.





MUSEUM TOUR – Duration 5 – 6 hrs.

Tour Cost : Rs 1,300 per person

Relics of India's 5000 year old history : see them at the National Museum on Janpath which has an excellent collection of ancient Indian bronzes, terracotta and wood sculptures dating back to the Maurya period (2nd-3rd century) fine examples from the kingdom of south of India and archaeological finds from the Indus valley civilizations. Also visit the National Museum of Natural History.



SANTUSHTI / DELHI HAAT Duration 5 - 6 hrs.

A shopping experience un-paralleled. Santushti is a complex run by Airforce Wives Welfare Association and houses various shops and boutiques that boast designer Indian handicrafts, jewellery, pottery, exquisite Indian fabrics and a host of other Indian treasures.



ART GALLERIES TOUR : Duration 5 - 6 hrs.

Tour Cost : Rs 1,300 per person

Stroked on the canvas - old and new. Watch the colours of India come alive at some of the leading art galleries of the city. See the delightfully detailed and colourful miniatures from the different school of art including the Mughal, Rajasthani and Pahari. Besides traditional art, India also has some fine examples of contemporary art. View the works of India's well known artists on this tour.

♣ **SARI-TYING, CARPET WEAVING DEMONSTRATIONS, HENNA APPLICATION :**
Duration 4 - 5 hrs.

Experience and enjoy traditional Indian dresses and participate in informal demonstrations on tying sarees of various materials. The sari, is a single piece of fabric measuring about 06 yards (5.5 mtrs.) has four ages been the traditional dress of Indian wo man. On this tour, see and learn the simple procedure of wearing a sari. Also see the age-old process of carpet weaving.



Henna-Mehendi a plant extract as known in India is a natural dye, considered auspicious, purifying and cooling is artistically drawn on the hands and feet of the bride during the wedding to bring good luck.



Craft forms of India heritage from Aryan Era to present day are found here. An insight into Carpets, Jewellery, Hand-woven Cottons and Silk and many more handicrafts through demonstration of their creation housed at Cottage Industries.

♣ **ANAND GRAM - SANSKRITI : Duration 5 - 6 hrs.**

Tour Cost : Rs 1,300 per person

Visit to Anand Gram, the artist's village on the outskirts of Delhi. The village has been set up to promote and encourage young artists with creative talents. An exciting and unusual experience. Sanskriti Pratishthan, (or foundation) is an oasis for the creative community to stay, reflect and create in a stimulating atmosphere. The Kendra is a seven acre complex with 12 residential studios for artists around the globe to live and work in harmony with nature. It houses three unique museums, Museum of Every day Art, Museum of Indian Terracotta and Museum of Indian Textiles, a thousand trees, fragrant shrubs birds and butterflies. A visit to the Sanskriti Kendra will be an experience of a lifetime.

HERBAL BEAUTY & SHRINGAR DEMONSTRATION
Duration 5 – 6 hrs.

Tour Cost : Rs 3,750 per person

A visit to one of India's famous herbal beauty parlours run by Shahnaz Hussains, which will reveal some age-old secrets for preserving beauty and youth.



TEMPLE TOUR (On all days except Monday)
Duration 6 - 7 hrs.

Tour Cost : Rs 1,500 per person

The Lotus Temple is the most captivating edifice situated in Southern part of New Delhi. Shaped like a lotus and the temple is worth exploring. Built by the Baha'i community, it offers the visitor a serenity that pervades the temple and its artistic design. Lunch – at the Lotus Temple.



The Akshardham monument, built of sandstone and marble is one of the wonders of the modern India. It consists of 234 ornately carved pillars, 9 ornate domes, 20 quadrangled shikhars, a spectacular Gajendra Pith (plinth of stone elephants) and 20,000 murtis and statues of India's great sadhus, devotees, acharyas and divine personalities. The monument is a fusion of several architectural styles of pink stone and pure white marble. Pink stone symbolizes bhakti (devotion) in eternal bloom and white marble of absolute purity and eternal peace.
