



BHARAT DUBE, CHIEF EXECUTIVE AND CHAIRMAN, IP GURUS (SINGAPORE)

Mr. Bharat Dube is based in Singapore and is the founder and chief executive of IP Gurus (www.ip-gurus.com), established last year, and Chairman of Strategic Intellectual Property Information Ltd. (www.sipi-in.com), a web monitoring company located in Noida. Prior to this, Mr. Dube headed the litigation and enforcement team of Richemont, the Swiss luxury goods maker, for almost two decades. At Richemont, Mr. Dube was particularly responsible for the Group's two principal brands, Cartier and Montblanc. He led the effort to successfully obtain trade dress protection for the shapes of several iconic Cartier watches (including the Pasha and Tank American), Montblanc's Starwalker pens, and the 'Three Ring' trademark featured on Montblanc's Meisterstück range in the United States. He has appeared as an expert witness in court proceedings in Italy, Norway, the United Kingdom and the United States.

Earlier, Mr. Dube worked with the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), in Geneva. Mr Dube is a graduate of the United World College of the Atlantic, Harvard University (A.B.magna cum laude, 1983) and Duke Law School (J.D., 1986). He has lectured extensively at IP symposia around the world, including events sponsored by the International Anti-Counterfeiting Coalition, the International Trademark Association, WIPO and various bar associations.
